Camp Open House: Parents, campers, and friends of the camp are welcome to visit and tour the camp; meet the Executive Director and some of the camp staff at the YMCA Camp of Maine.

Check-in: SUNDAY from 1:00 - 3:00 P.M.
NO check-in's before 1:00 P.M.

Check-out: SATURDAY from 9:30 - 11:00 A.M.

Directions to Camp: Take the Maine Turnpike & Interstate 95 to Exit 109 -- Augusta/Winthrop--follow Winthrop/Route 202. Proceed 5.6 miles WEST on Route 202 turn left on Route 135 (also the Winthrop Center Rd.) Camp is located 1.5 miles on the left at the large wooden sign with the flower bed. Sign says YMCA Camp of Maine.

Camp Programs: All programs are elective except swim instruction. Campers testing below the YMCA "Fish" level will be enrolled in the appropriate class. We offer a wide variety of activities: archery, soccer, softball, kayaking, pottery, art & crafts, outdoor life, sailing, canoeing, tennis, dodge ball and more.

Questions regarding forms call main office: 207-395-4200 before arriving at the camp with your camper.

Laundry Service: Applies for campers staying **THREE (3) or more CONSECUTIVE weeks ONLY.**

Medical Information: Completion of the **Health Form IS MANDATORY** for admission to camp. A health exam has to be completed by an approved *licensed medical physician every (2) two years.*

An update is required annually if any changes.

Sports physicals are acceptable.

Immunizations: Camper's immunizations **required** on Health Form with complete listing.

Signatures: **PHYSICIAN & PARENT** are *both* required on the Health Form.

HEALTH FORMS are to be received TWO (2) weeks prior to camper's arrival.

****The camp nurse reviews Health Forms prior to camper's arrival as she may need to contact parent with a question.**

Medications: All medications (prescriptions and non-prescriptions) must be given to the camp nurse at check-in. Campers with pre-existing medical conditions must bring enough medication to last the entire time at camp.

KEEP all medication in the original packaging and bottle identifies the prescribing physician, the name of the medication, the dosage, and frequency of administration.

Refer to the Health Form Requirement Letter.

Paperwork: Health Form, ALL Letters to Leaders, Teen Adventure Camp & Leader-in-Training paperwork **ARE** to be received **TWO (2) weeks** prior to camper's arrival.

Cabin Assignments: Cabin assignments are based on the year & month camper was born; placement consideration is given the utmost time & judgment by our management team.

Camp tries it's best to accommodate bunkmate requests as indicated on enrollment cards; however, we reserve the right to place campers in age appropriate cabins we feel will benefit all of our campers and staff.
***We thank you for your cooperation in this matter.**

Visiting Days: Campers, who are staying more than two weeks, may be visited by parents and relatives or may go home between sessions on change days; please call.

*The Parent/Guardian **must** notify the executive director in advance that the camper is leaving property for the day.*

***** Camper *must* sign out then sign back in at dining hall.**

Tipping is not in the best interest of the camper or staff, nor is it the best way to thank our staff for a fine job.

***A thank you letter to the cabin leader or a donation to the camp's Scholarship Fund in the person's name tells the executive director of a job well done and helps send a needy child to camp.**
