

CAMPER CLOTHING & EQUIPMENT LIST

The following are guidelines for packing for your stay at camp.

We ask that you pack enough clothing for entire stay at camp if you are staying for one or two weeks.

☺ **Mark clothing & equipment with your camper's name on it.** ☺

WHAT TO PACK:

Camper's Prescription: Medications must be in its original bottles & given to nurse at check-in

2 Bathing Suits (girls, one-piece suits required)

Hat or baseball cap

Jeans / Pants

Long sleeve shirts

Pajamas

Raincoat / Poncho or Jacket

Sandals

Shorts

Socks

Sneakers

Sweatshirts / Sweatpants

T-Shirts

Underwear

Caddy or bucket - to carry shower supplies

Comb and/or brush

Personal Hygiene supplies

Shampoo

Shower Shoes / Flip Flops

Soap & soap dish container

Toothbrush and Toothpaste

Tissues

3+ Towels & Face Cloths

Footlockers available at Walmart

Backpack

****Camera and case w/ extra film or digital

Comforter and Sheets (if no sleeping bag)

Pillow with Pillow case

Sleeping Bag

Fishing Pole (stored separately, not in cabin)

Flashlight with extra Batteries

Insect Repellent (***) must be Non-aerosol)

Reading material

Softball mitt w/ camper's name written on it (optional)

Sunscreen

Tennis Racket w/ camper's name written on it (optional)

Water Bottle

Self-addressed Envelopes w/ **Postage stamps**

Stationery and writing supplies

*Laundry Bag * w/ campers' name printed on it

Pertains to camper's who are attending 3 weeks or more of camp only.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

NO CELL PHONES

LEAVE: skateboards, large radios, TV's, game boys, pocket games, pocketknives, money & valuables at home.

**IPOD'S used in cabin; camp is not responsible for them!*

NEW: LAUNDRY SERVICE applies to camper's who are attending **three (3) or more consecutive weeks** of camp **ONLY**.

LOST AND FOUND: Parents check **Lost & Found** area when picking up your camper before leaving camp.

~ ~ **In order to send mail** - stamps must be purchased at the Camp Store during Check-in; OR you need to provide your camper with stamps prior to their arrival. Canadian campers: You must purchase US stamps. DO NOT give your camper Canadian stamps. Campers from other countries must purchase stamps through the camp store.
